

# The Social Protection Floors: Achieving social security for all Implementing an international concept on the national level

**7-11 November 2016 Geneva, Switzerland**

The concept of the Social Protection Floors (SPF) was adopted by the International Labour Conference in June 2012 and since then has gained tremendous support on the international level. The potential of SPF to eradicate poverty and to balance economic and social uncertainties has been reaffirmed by its prominent role in the Sustainable Development Goals.

The Friedrich-Ebert-Stiftung has decided to put the concept of SPF at the centre of its activities in the area of social justice. Therefore, some country offices wish to intensify their work around SPF. This seminar aims at providing in-depth conceptual knowledge of SPF, a better understanding of possible stumbling blocks for achieving SPF and assisting to develop projects in the respecting countries.
